PAPER PLATE OWLS

Materials:

- Paper plates uncoated basic plates
- Paint or markers
- Construction paper or regular white paper
- Scissors
- Glue



What to Do:

Step 1: Fold both sides of the plate in toward the center.

Step 2: Then fold over the top of the plate to make the owl's head.

Step 3: Now it's time to color your owl—get creative!!

Step 4: Glue the wings and head down. Then paint feathers on the body.

Step 5: Cut out the eyes, beak, and feet from construction paper or regular white paper. If you are using white paper, make sure to drawn in your owl's eyes and color the feet and beak.

TIP: Plastic milk caps are perfect when you need to draw a nice, round circle!





Step 6: Glue the eyes, beak, and feet to the owl's body, and your owl craft is complete!
