

WINE CORK OWLS

Materials:

- Corks
- Buttons
- Material scraps - flannel, felt, old T-shirts, etc.
- Glue gun

What to Do:

For the wings . . .

- Cut narrow, pointy ovals from a piece of fabric. Then cut a smaller version from another fabric scrap. Hot-glue the smaller “wing” to the larger one. Then hot-glued them to the sides of the cork.

For the eyes . . .

- Get creative! An idea is to hot-glue small black buttons onto a couple of larger white buttons. Hot-glue your owl’s eyes onto the cork.

For the eyes . . .

- Cut a small, triangle out of a piece of fabric. Hot-glue it just below the owl’s eyes.

Want to display your cork owl creations? Hot-glue them onto a sturdy stick.
